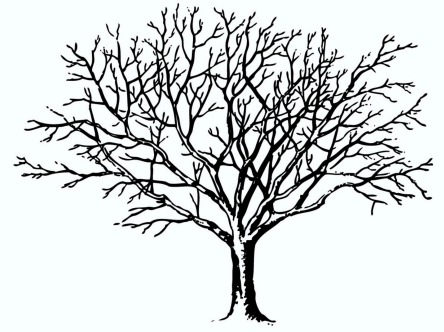


ADOPT A TREE

Kurilpa Futures (KF), as one of its projects, has requested Brisbane City Council (BCC) to increase the tree coverage on the streets of Kurilpa Peninsula (KP) - West End, Highgate Hill and South Brisbane - to improve shade for pedestrians and cyclists, and the overall green canopy.

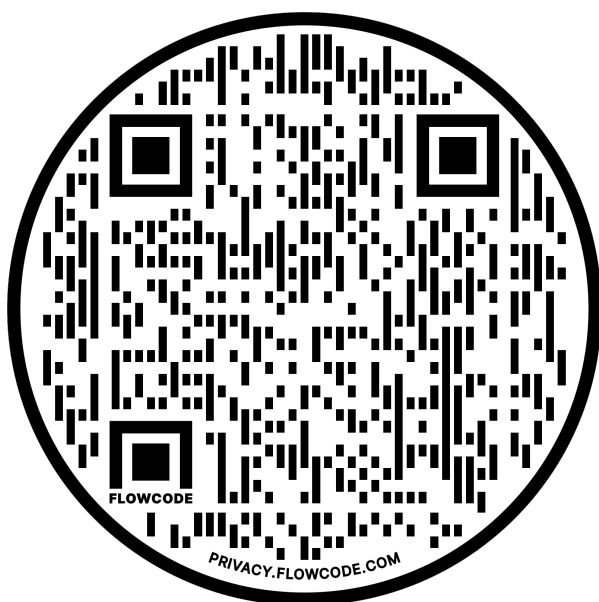
As Stage 1 we have targeted Vulture Street between Boundary and Hardgrave and hopefully trees will be planted before the Christmas period. Followup stages will be undertaken in 2022.

When BCC plants a street tree, they provide some Tender Loving Care (TLC) for a while then it's up for adoption. It's not easy if you're young, alone, thirsty and unloved on busy inner-city streets. You get broken, you get pushed over, you get whipper-snipped, you put roots down but there's no water...

This is where we hope the locals will help. KF is asking residents and businesses to adopt trees nearby and help with the goal 'To Grow Brisbane's Urban Forest' (BCC). You can show the love via regular watering, general TLC, encouraging your neighbours to become tree adopters and reporting damage or concerns to Council (Contact BCC at 34038888).
